**Title:** **Beyond Trump: Greens continue to fight for peace, democracy, fundamental rights and a rules based world order**

### **Resolution text**

1 The re-election of Donald Trump as President of the United States on 5th  
2 November 2024 is a bad day for US citizens; Europe and the world face massive  
3 challenges. Unlike last time, the Republicans have won a majority of the votes  
4 and are preparing for a radical restructuring of the US government apparatus and  
5 a comprehensive government programme.

6 This time, with a majority in the Senate and the House of Representatives, like-  
7 minded right-wing judges on the Supreme Court and Trump in the White House, it  
8 will be much easier to put these plans into practice.

9 **In the face of these growing challenges, we, as Greens and pro-European forces**  
10 **commit to the following actions:**

#### 11 **1. Support Ukraine's fight for democracy and sovereignty**

12 We will continue to support Ukraine in its struggle against Russia's  
13 illegal war of aggression, ensuring that Europe provides not only military  
14 and financial assistance but also long-term support for Ukraine's  
15 resilience, economic development, sustainable reconstruction and the rule  
16 of law. Where Trump challenges security cooperation, we will continue to  
17 build common security, starting with organised European military  
18 procurement and defining the next steps towards the pooling of  
19 capabilities by member states. The gradual pooling of capabilities by  
20

21 willing Member States under the framework of the Common Security and  
22 Defence Policy (CSDP) can increase military capacity with less cost and  
discourage go-it-alone actions.

## 23 **2. Promote peace and stability in the Middle East**

24 In light of Trump's past policies that have destabilized the Middle East,  
25 we will work for a balanced and constructive EU foreign policy that  
26 promotes peace, supports civil society and democratic movements, and works  
27 to resolve conflicts through diplomacy.

## 28 **3. Combat the far-right and defending democracy**

29 We will continue to oppose the rise of the far-right in Europe, which  
30 benefits from and supports Trump's nationalist and authoritarian agenda.  
31 We will defend democratic institutions, promote transparency, and advocate  
32 for reforms that strengthen European unity and solidarity, ensuring that  
33 the EU remains a beacon of hope for democracy around the world. We will  
34 also work for more effective instruments to protect the rule of law at EU  
35 level. For example we advocate for a stricter application of budget  
36 conditionality and would like to lower the thresholds for the use of the  
37 Art. 7 mechanism.

38 We make sure that no EU funds are paid to autocrats. To do this, the EU  
39 Commission must use the conditionality regulation, which involves the  
40 Council and the EU values conditionality, which it can trigger itself. If  
41 member states do not apply EU law, the Commission must sue them and ask  
42 the court to impose fines on those who do not apply rulings.

## 43 **4. Reject protectionism and economic nationalism**

44 We oppose Trump's protectionist policies and advocate for fair, rules-  
45 based international trade. In the face of Trump's proposals we will  
46 continue to work for a European industry that is resilient and much less  
47 dependent on authoritarian regimes. A European industrial policy for the  
48 climate-neutral transformation of the European industry is key to this.

## 49 **5. Lead the global fight against climate change**

50 Trump's climate denialism has delayed global progress on climate action.  
51 Europe must take the lead in the fight against climate change by setting  
52 ambitious carbon reduction targets, investing in green technologies, and  
53 supporting a just transition for workers and communities. We will also  
54 push for global agreements that address the climate crisis equitably and

55 prevent further environmental degradation.

56 **6. Defend the common good against a government takeover by the ultra-rich**

57 Trump funded his campaign by selling out the government out to Elon Musk  
58 and other ultra-rich people. We fight for the many, not the few, by  
59 demanding tax cooperation rather than tax competition. We invest in the  
60 common goods for all Europeans and fund it with EU taxes on windfall  
61 profits, the biggest polluters and a digital tax on big international  
62 digital companies.

63 **7. Investing in a green, healthy and socially just future**

64 We strongly oppose a society where only the wealthy have influence and  
65 power is built on division. We want Europe to be a place of equal  
66 opportunities and social cohesion. Events such as the Corona pandemic, the  
67 Russia's full-scale invasion in Ukraine and the resulting cost-of-living  
68 crisis have created economic insecurity and increased social inequalities.  
69 We will invest in affordable housing and reduce rents. We want to use the  
70 money from the Emission Trading System for renovations to reduce energy  
71 bills and invest in public transport to make mobility more affordable,  
72 including outside cities. We want to stop billions of public money being  
73 spent on fossil fuel subsidies and invest it instead in the green  
74 transition. We will increase EU resources through greater tax justice to  
75 work together for a healthier environment for us and future worth living  
76 for our children.

77 **8. Standing up to bigotry, hate, and desinformation**

78 We reject the politics of fear, division, and hate promoted by Trump and  
79 the far-right promote. We will advocate for policies that foster  
80 tolerance, intercultural dialogue, women's rights, an inclusive society  
81 and respect for diversity. We will continue to work for a world where the  
82 right to abortion is a reality and where everyone can be who they are and  
83 love who they want to. We will continue to work for a rules-based internet  
84 that fights hate and disinformation, not promotes it.

85 **9. Global solidarity and resistance**

86 We will continue to build global alliances with progressive movements,  
87 particularly through the Global Greens network, to resist  
88 authoritarianism, support democracy, strive for social justice and promote  
89 sustainability. Europe must stand in solidarity with those fighting for

90 human rights, democracy, and climate justice across the globe.

91 Trump's re-election is a call to action: The forces of authoritarianism,  
92 nationalism, and climate denial are growing, but Europe has the power and  
93 responsibility to lead in defense of democracy, human rights, and a sustainable  
94 future. We will fight to ensure that Europe remains united, democratic, and  
95 resilient in the face of these challenges, offering a hopeful alternative to  
96 Trumpism and the far-right across the world.
