In the campaign leading up to the 2024 election, we faced several important challenges that should serve as key areas for us to focus on in the years to come:

- Unlike in 2019, setting the agenda on climate and environmental issues was less prominent. Despite the urgency of climate disruption, there is no more mass mobilization in the streets around environmental issues. Also, electoral debates were framed around economic issues of immediate and individual concern, with purchasing power dominating electoral discussions all over the EU.
- At the same time, Green parties are no longer the sole advocates for environmental issues. In many European countries, we now face competition from parties that have integrated climate policies into their platforms. Greens must work to ensure that our message remains distinct, relevant, and credible.
- European cooperation has always been at the heart of Green parties. However, the EU faces setbacks, and so do pro-European parties. How can Greens not only defend Europe, but also advocate for a better, more inclusive Europe?
