Resolution text

Insert from line 75 to 76:

 arms, ammunition, drones and equipment to the RSF, SAF or affiliated armed groups

Call on all EU Member States, in line with the Arms Trade Treaty and the EU Common Position on arms exports, to immediately suspend the authorisation of arms transfers to States credibly alleged to be supplying arms to parties to the conflict in Sudan, including the UAE and other regional actors, where there is a clear risk that such arms could be used to commit or facilitate serious violations of international humanitarian or human rights law

Explanation / Comment

We need to prevent states to support armed groups with arms fueling even further this conflict. Nevertheless, we should also acknowledge that EU Member States (including Belgium) keep exporting and supplying arms to states such as UAE. Stop exporting EU arms to UAE or any complicit states should prevent us to see EU arms to be used in that conflict.
