Review the inclusion of coercive control (**an act or a pattern of acts of assault, threats, humiliation and intimidation or other abuse that is used to harm, punish, or frighten their victim**) in criminal law (included in England, Wales, Scotland, Ireland, Hawaii, New South Wales, and Queensland, is currently under review in Canada, and other US states), ensuring that it is accompanied by comprehensive training for law enforcement to minimize errors in identifying the perpetrator (primary aggressor).
