I served on Waterford City & County Council for two and a half years - with one year as Deputy Metropolitan Mayor of Waterford. During this time, I progressed projects in the areas of Active Travel, road safety, equality, disability, planning, problem gambling and community. I was also Chair of the Women's Caucus on the Council and a regular contributor to local radio.
