

Not only have I been at this European level for years (even participating in EGP Committee meetings as FYEG Co-spokesperson), but I worked through every level of the Scottish Greens - from the local board to the national executive.

January 2024 - PRESENT

Democracy is under attack, and for the last two years I have developed an acute understanding of how authoritarian governments operate through working in close contact with them in the Council of Europe, in my role defending democracy, human rights and rule of law. I successfully convinced initially sceptical governments to pass the Council of Europe's first ever recommendation on Youth and Climate.

Greens need to rebuild trust with civil society. I coordinate daily with grassroots climate groups and NGOs around the world to build power for a more sustainable and just mobility system. I understand their concerns.

EGP's strategic priority is consolidation and supporting the growth of our parties through capacity building in areas such as communications and campaigns. I have supported dozens of organisations (such as Greens/EFA Campaigns and Outreach team) in exactly this.

With Benedetta Scuderi, I co-led FYEG to being a more united federation (e.g. agreeing a position on Israel-Palestine for the first time), with more members, more staff, and more money than ever before.
