We demand fair pensions for all seniors in the EU. This also includes securing freedom of movement for those on guaranteed income pensions to be able to live all over the EU and bring their pensions with them. We believe that the mandatory retirement age should be a concept of the past. We want to have strong long-term

Explanation / Comment

It's important to ensure that all EU citizens have the right to live all over Europe and have freedom of movement including those aged especially those with disability, women etc who have been adversely impacted by the European Court Of Justice decision that guaranteed income pensions shall be categorized as a minimum benefit thus only paid to residents of the country granting the benefit i.e. retired people being unable to move within EU as their guaranteed income pension won't come with them a right previously accorded to them. This will impact citizens in different countries differently. In Sweden for example this means that 50% of old age retired people will not be able to live in another EU country due to the removal of their pension should they move.
